If the moving party would like to continue the matter to cure defects showing in the probate notes, he or she may do so by sending an email to probate@yubacourts.org no later than 2:00 the Friday before the hearing. The email is to state the case name and number, and indicate a Monday date to which the continuance is requested. If such an email request is timely made, no appearance is required at the hearing and the matter will be continued unless the probate notes indicate that the Court has directed otherwise.
